## The application timeline:

- The total amount of time needed for the whole process was 6 months
- Setting the team: 1 month
- Brainstorming and discussion on the direction and the focus of the project proposal: 2 months
- Writing and proofreading: 3 months
- Submission of the proposal in November 2022, received the response in March 2023.
- April – July 2023 communication with CINEA project leader on clarification parts in the proposal
- Start of the project October 2023

Making sure to read the instructions in the application thoroughly



Extensive talks with all project participants



Making sure to answer all the requested information in clear and simple language



Making sure there is a grant writer who will guide you



## Why it was successful for us:

Based on our previous experience, we had very strong lessons learned

Analysis of what worked and what didn't in previous applications

Reading the instructions closely

Starting early

Evaluation results: high score - 80.50 (threshold 55)
