New ecodesign and energy labelling compliance support facility for suppliers and retailers

LIFE-2022-CET-COMPLIANCE

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Context

Ecodesign and Energy Labelling Working Plan 2022-2024:

*“at least 10% of the potential energy savings are lost due to **non-compliance**... representing **178 TWh** and **EUR 6.4 billion** annual expenditure for consumers on energy bills (based on 2020 energy price levels).”*



Objective

Non-compliance with ecodesign and energy labelling requirements is a **significant and growing concern**

- **Increase the visibility of (existing) resources to economic operators, helping them comply**



Scope

- Establish a facility combining both **reactive and proactive assistance**:
 - raise capacity of suppliers and, in particular, retailers through **targeted and timely communication and training campaigns**
 - attention to **reaching small and medium size suppliers and retailers**
 - use or adapt existing (or create new) technical **guidance and promotional material**. The facility should not invent or take responsibility for legal interpretations.



Scope

and...

- **disseminate** knowledge about **available guidance / resources**, including **EPREL** (European Product Registry for Energy Labelling)
- set-up a **help-line service** to address enquiries from economic operators
- ensure adequacy of information by **proactively liaising with the Commission** or the **competent national authorities**

Consortium

- Involve relevant stakeholders (e.g. European and national level organisations), including **at least**:
 - ✓ **European organisations representing economic operators: min. of 5 partners** covering together at least 2/3 of the EU Member States;
 - ✓ **European organisations representing public or non-profit sector: min. of 2 partners**, covering together at least 2/3 of the EU Member States.



Consortium

Necessary to ensure:

- Access to (networks of) **experts with technical knowledge**
- Sufficient resources allowing **swift follow-up to operators** using the help-line service
- Expertise in **communication** and **outreach**



Impacts

- Increased **understanding** of and **compliance** with **EU ecodesign and energy labelling** legislation
- Number of **economic operators engaged and informed** by actions aiming at improving their understanding of new legislative acts (e.g. new or rescaled labels), at least 5 000 per million Euro of EU funding.
- Primary energy savings triggered by the project (in GWh/year).
- Renewable energy generation triggered by the project (in GWh/year).
- Investments in sustainable energy renovation triggered by the project (cumulative, in million Euro).
