#### Policy drivers

REPowerEU: phase out EU dependence on fossil fuels → energy efficiency

European Green Deal's Renovation Wave: double renovation rate of buildings

 Recast Energy Efficiency Directive: public sector leading on energy efficiency (Articles -5-7) – targets to be achieved now by <u>all</u> public bodies at national, regional and local levels





#### Challenge

- Create, operationalise and sustain long-term structures to support public authorities in developing and implementing public buildings renovation
- Accelerate energy renovations of public buildings to nearly zero-energy buildings (nZEB) or zeroemission buildings (ZEB).
- Develop and deploy long-term financial and market-based instruments to finance the renovation wave in the public sector







#### Scope – What proposals are we looking for? (1)

- Establish and operate regional/national facilitation structures to accelerate the renovation wave in the public sector → scale is important!
- Governance, mandate, geographical coverage and sustainability of the facilitation structures to be established
- Comprehensive, all-inclusive services (A-Z) to public authorities
- Retroffting to nZEB or ZEB standards







#### Scope – What proposals are we looking for? (2)

- <u>Describe</u> in your proposal how you will:
  - Ensure long-term sustainability of the facilitation structure by obtaining stakeholder support and becoming financially self-sustaining.
  - Mobilise and work with local authorities to identify and invest in the renovation of public buildings to nZEB and ZEB standards.
     Demonstrate buy-in from your local authorities in your proposal!
  - Integrate financial engineering to facilitate the use of financial instruments and market-based instruments; to increase blended finance of public and private sources; and to absorb relevant EU funds.





#### Scope – What proposals are we looking for? (3)

- <u>Describe</u> in your proposal how you will:
  - Integrate legal assistance to facilitate and prioritise the aggregation of building renovation projects with the aim to upscale overall renovation and attract private investors.
  - Develop efficient procurement processes ensuring that renovations are delivered at pace, enabling the bundling/upscaling of renovation projects and ensuring high quality of renovation works.

#### Scope – Other important information

 Build on experiences and solutions developed by 5 ongoing RENOPUB projects and over 150 ELENA and PDA/MLEI projects

 Proposals may be submitted by a single applicant or by applicants from a single eligible country.

Project size: indicative EU contribution EUR 1m – 1.5m







### **Expected Impacts**

Proposals should result in long-term facilitation structures which are tested, implemented and operational at the end of the action, i.e. delivering renovation projects to nZEB and ZEB standards.

Proposals should quantify their impacts using the indicators listed below, where relevant, as well as other project-specific performance indicators:

- Number of public buildings renovated to nZEB or ZEB standards targeted with the facilitation structure.
- Number of public authorities supported through the services of the facilitation structures.
- Average percentage of energy savings per investment project.
- Additional amount of funding support (EU and/or private sources) leveraged into the territory thanks to facilitation services.

- Primary energy savings triggered by the project (in GWh/year).
- Renewable energy generation triggered by the project (in GWh/year).
- Investments in sustainable energy triggered by the project (cumulative, in million Euro).
- Number of jobs directly and indirectly created.
