





Eligibility conditions

To be eligible, the applicants (beneficiaries and affiliated entities) must:

- be legal entities (public or private bodies)
- be established in one of the eligible countries, i.e.:



European Commission

Consortium composition

Minimum 3 independent entities from 2 different EU countries that include at least:





universities
educational institutions
research centres
organisations providing vocational training



an industry representative body

including industry associations representative groups chamber of commerce legally established maritime clusters

The coordinator must be established in an EU Member State.



Geographic location (target countries)

Proposals shall relate to activities:

- Taking place in EU territory and waters
- North Sea, Baltic Sea, Black Sea, the Atlantic and the Mediterranean Sea (WestMED and the Adriatic-Ionian Seas) & EU Outermost regions
- Focus can be on a part/sub-region and Outermost Regions
- Non-EU countries: only eligible for funding if it is necessary for the implementation of the projects – see list in the call



Attention to:

- Clearly indicate in the proposal the chosen theme(s) / priority
- Design your proposed actions WITH Industry representatives
- Develop regional partnerships consider skill needs of sea basins
- Develop inter-/multi-disciplinary approaches, tackle a variety of blue economy sectors, to the extent possible
- Partners across different sea basins and notably, as far as relevant, from Outermost Regions (ORs)



Requirements

Who can apply?

 Consortium of at least 3 applicants from 2 different countries

How much can you get?

- co-funding rate 80%
- 24-36 months
- 7 8 projects between €800,000 and €1,200,000 in EU contribution

What are we looking for?

- innovative cooperation projects, bringing together:
 - industry representative body
 - Educational / training organisation
