

LIFE Programme in Belgium

The LIFE Programme is the EU's funding instrument for environment and climate action. It has been running since 1992 and has co-financed more than 6 000 projects across the EU and in neighbouring countries. LIFE has contributed almost \in 8 billion to these projects, amounting to around two-thirds of the projects' overall budget of \in 12 billion. The LIFE Programme contributes directly to the objectives and targets of the European Green Deal.







FOCUS ON 2023-2024

LIFE NATURE & BIODIVERSITY

The Nature and Biodiversity sub-programme aims to protect and restore Europe's nature and to halt and reverse biodiversity loss. The subprogramme contributes to the implementation of the EU Birds and Habitats directives, the development and management of the Natura 2000 network, the Invasive Alien Species Regulation, and supports the achievement of the objectives of the EU Biodiversity strategy for 2030 and the newly adopted EU Nature Restoration Regulation.

Fair and effective financing for the environment and climate action in EU Overseas by 2030 (BESTLIFE2030)



> <u>Project summary</u>

The BESTLIFE2030 project aims to establish a financing facility to support biodiversity conservation and sustainable development in the EU Overseas regions. It empowers local stakeholders in Outermost Regions and Overseas Countries and Territories to define and implement tailored projects addressing effectively biodiversity challenges, including the sustainable use of ecosystem services. Ultimately, BESTLIFE2030 seeks to align these efforts with global strategies, contributing to the post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework and EU-level sustainability goals.

of **13** PROJECTS

There are 13 ongoing Nature & Biodiversity projects in Belgium. The **NID4BirdLIFE** project aims to reverse the decline of European kittiwakes by establishing a breeding site on the Princess Elisabeth Energy Island and integrating bird-friendly elements into offshore energy infrastructure; **LIFE ArdennEislek** focuses on restoring and reconnecting natural habitats in the Belgian Ardennes and Luxembourgish Eislek, thereby improving the conservation status of key species and fostering cross-border cooperation in nature protection; **LIFE AtlanticValleys** is dedicated to restoring degraded habitats in Wallonia's Atlantic Biogeographical Region, enhancing biodiversity in Natura 2000 sites; **LIFE HARWIN** seeks to implement large-scale restoration in Atlantic valley ecosystems; **LIFE DUNIAS** targets invasive alien species (IAS) in the Belgian coastal zone; **LIFE Connexions** aims to enhance the conservation status of key species while reconnecting grassland and forest habitats in Wallonia; **LIFE Nardus & Limosa** aims to restore species-rich Nardus grasslands in the Campine region of Belgium and the Netherlands, focusing on innovative phosphorus-mining methods to support breeding meadow birds and enhance biodiversity; **LIFE RIPARIAS** and **LIFE VALLEES ARDENNAISES** focus on innovative IAS management and ecological restoration of river and forest habitats, respectively; **LIFE 3n-Bullfrog** targets the control of aquatic invasive fauna; **LIFE Green valleys** aims to connect habitat conservation with biomass management in Flanders and Poland; and **BESTLIFE2030**, which is explained in more details below.


There is also one ongoing Strategic Nature Project that has been co-funded in Belgium. **<u>B4B LIFE</u>** focuses on protecting and restoring biodiversity in Belgium by implementing Natura 2000 strategies.

CIRCULAR ECONOMY & QUALITY OF LIFE

The Circular Economy and Quality of LIFE sub-programme aims to facilitate the transition toward a sustainable, circular, toxic-free, energy-efficient and climate-resilient economy and to protect, restore and improve the quality of the environment. The sub-programme mainly supports implementing innovative and best practice solutions, in particular with regard to the circular economy, including recovery of resources from waste, water, air, noise, soil and chemical management as well as environmental governance and the and the new European Bauhaus. Priority is given to solutions that are ready to be implemented in close-tomarket conditions, at industrial or commercial scale.

LIFE CityTRAQ - TRaffic model for better Air Quality policies in cities



> <u>Project summary</u>

Based in the Dutch-speaking Flanders region of Belgium, LIFE CityTRAQ supports local administrators. The project uses tools to measure and analyse air quality and involve citizens in creating plans and initiatives to reduce pollution.

Partner cities Ghent, Antwerp, and Bruges are deploying additional air quality and traffic sensors to gather more local data on pollution hot spots and the effectiveness of their actions.



Belgium is currently engaged in several ongoing LIFE projects focused on environmental sustainability and pollution remediation. <u>BeLIFE</u> empowers citizens to enforce environmental rights under the European Green Deal, while <u>LIFE CityTRAQ</u> enhances local policymaking capacities in Flanders. <u>LIFE PFASTER</u> tackles PFAS pollution in Willebroek, and <u>LIFE CAPTURE</u> develops sustainable methods for managing PFAS contamination in soil and groundwater.

<u>CARBIP-LIFE</u> introduces aerogel-based insulation materials in construction, and <u>LIFE VIABLE</u> develops lignin-based epoxy resins to replace Bisphenol A. <u>PermaLIFE</u> demonstrates the production of circular myco-materials for insulation and packaging, while <u>STRAW LIFE</u> focuses on reducing resource use in the paper industry by using straw fibers, which is explained in more details below.

LIFE-ECOSWEEE addresses e-waste by testing initiatives to improve the collection of small Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and portable batteries, and **LIFE FRAC-IN** promotes innovative soil remediation technology. **LIFE PROGNOSES** develops criteria for assessing old-growth forests, while **LIFE oak processionary** reduces biocide use in regions affected by the oak processionary caterpillar. **LIFE NARMENA** increases water storage by removing metal pollutants, and **LIFE-IP C-MARTLIFE** focuses on waste management, including plastics and marine litter. Lastly, **LIFE BELINI** targets water management in the Scheldt River Basin.



LIFE CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION & ADAPTATION

The LIFE Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation sub-programme supports actions that support the implementation of the 2030 energy and climate policy framework and meet the European Union's commitments under the Paris Agreement on Climate Change. Projects under this strand contribute to the shift towards a sustainable, energy-efficient, renewable-energy-based, climate-neutral and climate-resilient economy.

Effective and Fair European Carbon Trading: Ensuring EU carbon pricing and revenue use serves the climate and society (LIFE EFFECT)



> **Project summary**

LIFE EFFECT seeks to enhance the knowledge, capacity, and networking of civil society and key stakeholders regarding the EU's Emissions Trading System for road transport and buildings (ETS 2) and the related Social Climate Fund (SCF). It aims to empower them to engage in national and EU policy processes, raise public awareness, and encourage support for emissions trading that benefits both the climate and society. By promoting decarbonisation and ensuring social justice for vulnerable groups, the project strives to achieve fair and effective carbon pricing.



Belgium has eight ongoing LIFE projects. LIFE TogetherFor1.5 focuses on aligning the EU's climate action with the 1.5°C target of the Paris Agreement. **LIFE PwACT** is developing an integrated, multi-stakeholder approach to urban climate change adaptation, emphasizing Nature-Based Solutions (NBS). LIFE SPARC works to enhance the resilience of the Scheldt estuary and its urbanized surroundings to climate change impacts. Life SMART is developing innovative solutions to integrate renewable energy into steel manufacturing processes. LIFE ACLIMA seeks to demonstrate technologies that increase water availability and strengthen agricultural resilience to climate challenges like droughts, floods, and heatwaves. LIFE Wetlands-**4Cities** promotes the exchange between urban areas and nearby wetlands to enhance climate resilience for both cities and surrounding ecosystems. LIFE EFFECT is explained in more details below.


LIFE IP BE REEL!, which is a Strategic Integrated Project, aims to promote large-scale energy-efficient renovations in Flanders and Wallonia by developing tools, financial instruments, and guidelines for construction while fostering cooperation between regions and authorities.

LIFE CLEAN ENERGY TRANSITION

The LIFE Clean Energy Transition sub-programme supports the delivery of EU policies in the field of sustainable energy, in particular, the European Green Deal, the Energy Union (2030 energy and climate targets) and the European Union's 2050 long-term decarbonisation strategy. It aims to facilitate the transition towards an energy-efficient, renewable energy-based, climate-neutral and -resilient economy by funding actions of high EU added-value, which are targeted at breaking market barriers that hamper the transition to sustainable energy.

European Energy Communities Facility (ENERCOM)



> <u>Project summary</u>

ENERCOM Facility provides direct support to emerging energy communities across Europe, helping around 140 emerging initiatives to develop and implement business plans that trigger investments in sustainable energy. It builds on a European network of national experts and grassroot initiatives to bridge gaps and address needs felt by a wide array of EU energy communities. ENERCOM Facility is also implementing trainings and producing related capacity building material, with a specific focus on replicability of business models and long-term sustainability. Support to energy communities and dissemination activities complete the project's package.

of **16** PROJECTS

Within this sub-programme, 16 projects are currently ongoing, with 9 starting in 2024. The **SKILLSAFE-EU** project develops EU-wide guidelines for safely installing heat pumps using the low-GWP refrigerant R290. **CROSSFIT** transforms public sector energy efficiency by establishing "one-stop shops" in Greece, Portugal, and Spain, aiming to mobilise €3 billion for the energy transition. **GEAR-UP** creates a scalable market for energy efficiency through deep retrofits and the "Energy Host" model in Ireland and Spain. **SOCIALNRG** empowers vulnerable families to co-design energy communities, with pilots in Slovenia, Italy, and Belgium. **DeliverEEM** accelerates private finance for energy efficiency by enhancing the Energy Efficient Mortgage ecosystem. The **ENERCOM Facility** allocates €7 million to support 140 energy communities through grants and training. **EcoSMEnergy** improves energy efficiency in SMEs with management tools and training. **RE-LEAF** enhances Energy House Limburg's services by developing solutions for complex renovations, while **Ecodesigned4LIFE** ensures civil society representation in ecodesign legislation through technical input and awareness-raising. **AUSTRIA**



OTHER

This section includes NGO operating grants and Capacity Building (CAP) projects.

In addition to providing direct co-financing to projects, LIFE also provides operating grants that enable non-profit entities to raise awareness of environmental issues and contribute to policy-making by representing citizens' views.

These organisations facilitate dialogue with stakeholders and ensure public concerns on the environment and climate change are addressed, providing a democratic counterbalance to other interests.



Participant in other LIFE projects

Belgium is participating in the <u>Net4LIFE</u> project, which is coordinated by Cyprus.



Brussels is hosting many European associations headquarters and has 15 ongoing projects.

Pesticide Action Network (PAN) Europe advocates for the elimination of pesticides, focusing on their impact on biodiversity, ecosystems, and public health. With extensive technical and scientific expertise, PAN Europe supports a shift towards non-toxic environments by promoting alternatives to pesticides and working towards its bans in urban and rural areas. Focusing on health issues, the **Health and Environment Al-Liance (HEAL)** operates through a network of doctors, nurses, patients, and non-profit health insurers. HEAL leverages global scientific and NGO networks to inform European policymakers on issues like clean air, hazardous chemicals protection, PFAS, pesticide reduction, and the EU's 2040 climate goals, including coal phase-out for better health. **Health Care without HarmEurope** focuses on greening procurement practice in the health care sector working on reducing pollution, GHG emissions and boost circularity of medical equipment.

The **Institute for European Environment Policy (IEEP)** proposes a programme to promote and scrutinise the European Green Deal within the Sustainable Development Goals framework. It aims to provide evidence-based recommendations to key decision-makers and stakeholders, focus on thematic areas, and enhance visibility with tools like the Green Deal Barometer and Implementation Tracker. Similarly, the **European Environment Bureau (EEB)** pushes for progressive environmental and climate policies, ensuring alignment with the European Green Deal objectives. It will engage with the European Commission, Parliament, and Council, focusing on laws and directives such as the Nature Restoration Law, Sustainable Product Policy Initiative, Green Claims, Packaging Waste, Industrial Emissions, REACH reforms, Ambient Air Quality Directives, and Sustainable Food Law.

Actions contributing to healthy, biodiverse and resilient oceans is strengthened through the support of LIFE to **Seas at Risk**, which integrates climate and biodiversity objectives in maritime policies, to **Shipbreaking Platform**, which aims at advocating for policies for a safe and clean management of ships at end-of-life phase.
