1. An AM for the 3 sea basins

- The new Assistance Mechanism for the 3 Sea Basins is intended to provide the necessary technical assistance for the implementation of the 3 sea basin strategies.
- In past years, each of the 3 EU Sea Basins have developed dedicated and individualised sets of priorities, which are organised differently and have been consolidated in the following strategic documents:
 - The WestMED Framework for Action & Roadmap priorities
 - The Atlantic Action Plan 2.0
 - The Common Maritime Agenda for the Black Sea
- The main thematic priorities covered by each Sea Basin Strategy, as well as the main thematic cooperation areas to date are summarised as follows


- 1. Coastguard functions cooperation (training, capacity building, search and rescue)

1.2. Thematic priorities in the Atlantic

The Atlantic Action Plan 2.0 comprises four (4) pillars which represent a practical way to make the Plan's vision a reality. All pillars are integrally interconnected and transregional by nature and address key challenges and aim to foster sustainable blue growth and contribute to the greater territorial cooperation and cohesion in the EU Atlantic area.



1.3. Thematic priorities in the Black Sea

- 1. Environmental dimension (GOAL I)
 - ✓ Address marine pollution and plastic litter
 - ✓ CMA GI/P3: Support sustainable fisheries and aquaculture in the Black Sea
- 2. Innovation (digitalization) dimension (GOAL II)
 - ✓ CMA GII/P1: Support Innovation
 - i. Digitalization of aquaculture, coastal tourism (including small cruise), natural and (underwater) cultural heritage.
- 3. Investment dimension (GOAL III)
 - ✓ CMA GIII/P2: Promote maritime entrepreneurship by supporting clusters, accelerators, SMEs and start-ups

2. Cooperation and synergies between initiatives and across sea basins

STREAMLINE AND UPSCALE THE SUPPORT PROVIDED SO FAR TO THE 3 EU SEA BASIN STRATEGIES

- Facilitating synergies between the various sea basins
- Supporting the systemic exchange of best practices
- Identifying consistent policy feedback
- Linked to the above, promoting informed planning of future actions




2.1 Cooperation and synergies between initiatives and across sea basins

KEY PRINCIPLES

- Establish and maintain **close relationships** through time with the main sea basin and policy-related initiatives.
- Effective **monitoring of funding** initiatives to be clearly linked with the concrete needs and deliverables in the context of each set of sea basin's priorities (coordination with WP3 based on action below).
- **Strong synergies** with policies, programmes, funding opportunities, scientific initiatives, etc. which are inherently involving different levels of engagement EU, sea basin, country, etc **within seabasins**
- Strong synergies across stakeholders, projects, emerging ideas that reflect the challenges/needs of ore than one seabasin – across seabasins

Summary of the remit of our activities specially devoted to actors and stakeholders...

Ensure permanent availability of the Assistance Mechanism at a national level

Liaise with relevant stakeholders, private sector, academia, national/regional authorities... cooperation

Identify and promote funding opportunities for projects in accordance with the WestMED, Atlantic and Black Sea Priorities & national priorities.

Assist and participate in the organization of national and international events (e.g. hackathons)

Network to support the development of the Action Plan/ Initiative/ Agenda (roadshows, conference presence...) Collect information on business development opportunities, public funding and private investment opportunities.

Advise and assist stakeholders in setting up project ideas and help to find partners across the National Hubs Networks
