Purpose of the meeting


- To demonstrate LIFE's ability to finance projects addressing a wide range of marine pollution issues (e.g. Marine Litter and Navigation/Shipping

- To provide participants with **excellent examples** of marine LIFE projects demonstrating the above.



The flexibility of LIFE

- LIFE is about positive impact on the environment!
- LIFE can tackle multitude of marine and marine pollution issues; from habitats, to marine litter, CO2 emissions, etc.
- LIFE applicants can make use of broad range of tools; from innovative projects, to best-practice, governance and awareness raising).
- LIFE offers flexible funding options; from small/focused projects (usually under 5 M€) to large national/regional strategic projects (usually above 10 M€).
- LIFE allows projects with diverse stakeholders; from single to multi beneficiary projects, involving authorities, industry, academia, NGOs, etc.




Important for LIFE 2021-27
