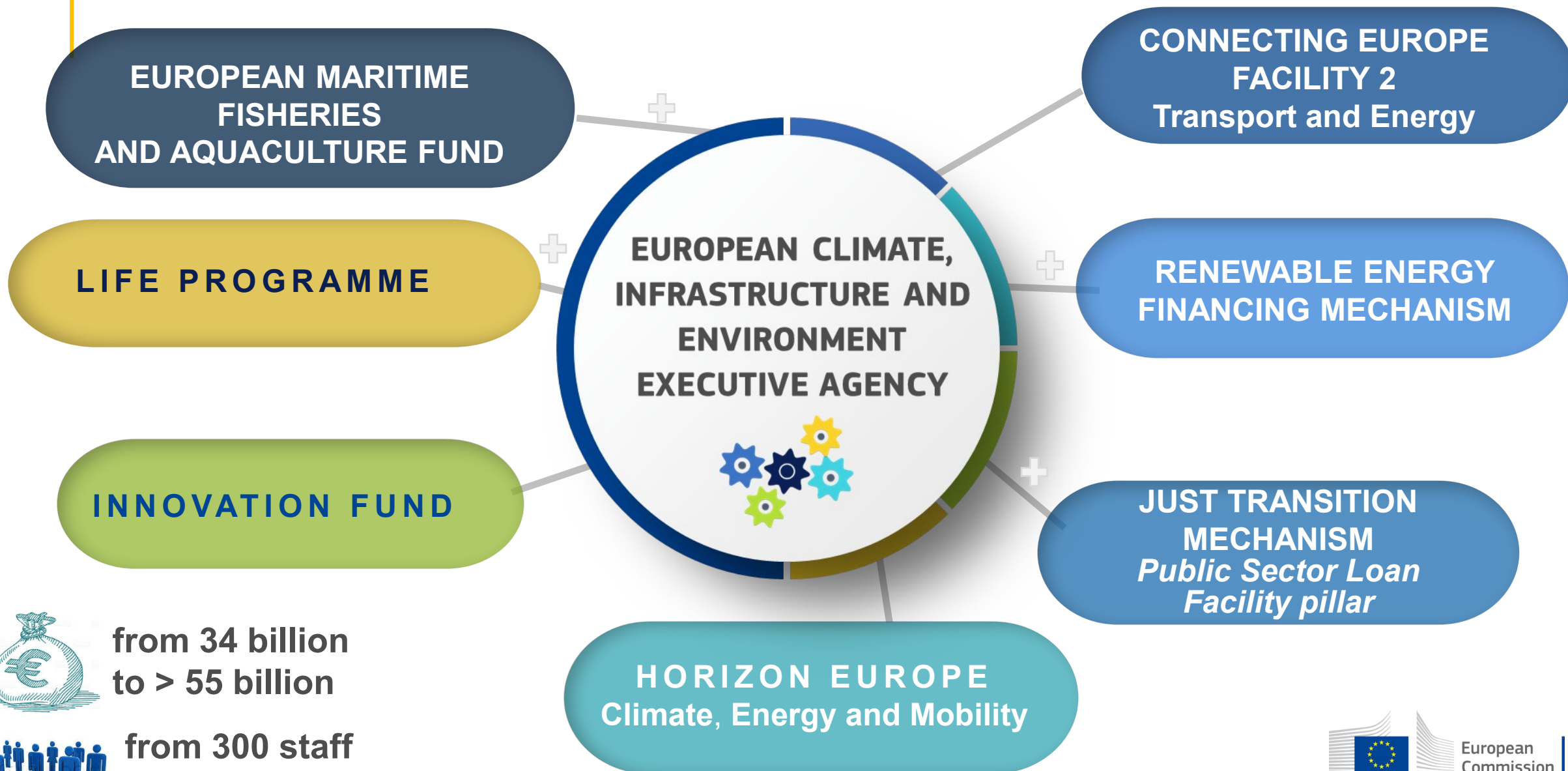

CEF 2021- 2027 Objectives: €33.71 billion*



Develop and modernise the trans-European networks in the fields of transport, energy and digital



Push the decarbonisation commitments



Emphasis on synergies among sectors

CEF Energy 2021- 2027



- Overall budget: **€5.84** billion for:
 - Projects of Common Interest (PCIs)
 - Cross – border renewable energy projects: **new window !**

CEF Energy: Cross – border renewable energy projects



- CINEA will implement Actions aiming to:
 - ✓ Promote joint planning, development and cost effective exploitation of RES to meet EU targets
 - ✓ Facilitate RES integration through energy storage and conversion facilities
 - ✓ Contribute to strategic uptake of innovative renewables technologies
 - ✓ Contribute to EU long term decarbonisation strategy
- Overall budget: **15%** of the CEF Energy budget (**€875 million** subject to market uptake)

- **Call for preparatory studies:** support to projects prior to becoming a cross-border project in the field of renewable energy
- Overall budget: **€1 million**
- **As of 2022:** calls for technical studies and works
