# LIFE-2024-CET-POLICY

## The Basics

Other Grants type of action – **95% co-funding**

Indicative budget for the topic **€ 6 million**

Minimum 3 applicants from **3 different eligible countries**

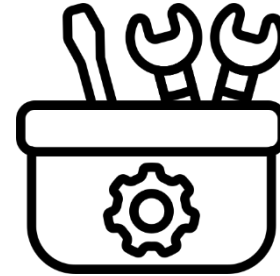
EU contribution up to **€ 1,75 million** per proposal would allow objectives to be addressed  
(not precluding submission and selection of proposals requesting other amounts)



# General Scope



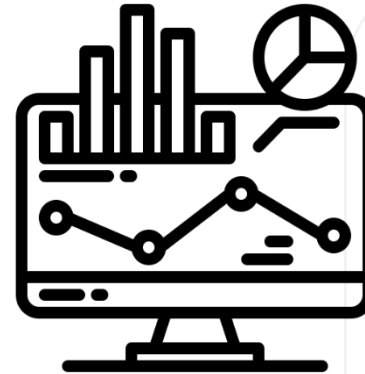
Scope, assess and model the impact of **implementation options**, including non-energy impacts



Provide support, technical advice and tools for **contextualisation and specification of requirements**



Support the **monitoring and evaluation** of policy implementation

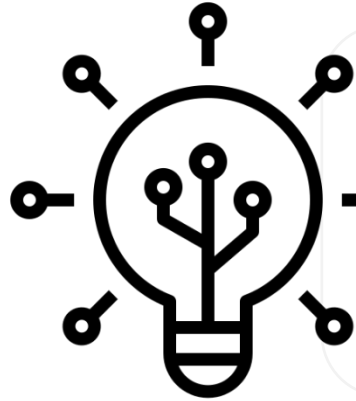


- Develop + support approaches for **integrated collection of data, calculation/accounting, verification, monitoring, evaluation and reporting** across legislation
- Monitor and model energy and **non-energy impacts** of integrated solutions; gather data for the energy and buildings sector.



Sharing of **best practices** within and across Member States

# Scope A: Support for the implementation of the Energy Efficiency Directive (EED)



**Energy Efficiency First Principle**, supporting operational implementation and developing assessment methodologies + tools and benchmarks



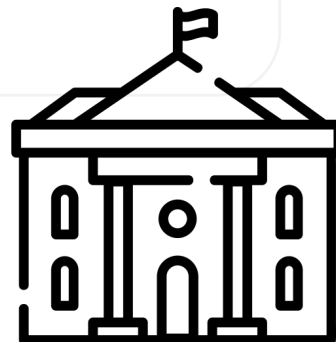
**Energy Savings Obligations + Energy Efficiency Obligation Schemes**, supporting the design/ implementation and calculation/ evaluation of measures



**Energy Efficiency targets**, including new methods to collect/ integrate sources of data, forecast trends and evaluate policies/ measures



**Energy Services**, support for establishing standard contracts + quality control schemes.



Role of the **public sector**, support for gathering and calculating data from public bodies



# Scope B: Support for the implementation of the Renewable Energy Directive (RED)

Support public authorities in charge of the transposition and implementation of the Directive  
Addressing only one of the areas below

## 1. Permit-granting process

- *Joint development of new tools sharing of best practices, training programmes for speeding up and streamlining permitting procedures through an **EU community of practitioners** in RES permitting*



## 2 Development of plans designating renewables acceleration areas

- *for one or more broad types of renewable energy sources*

## 3. Update, monitoring and /or evaluation of the implementation of national/regional/local frameworks implementing RED provisions on **renewables self-consumption**

- *esp. practical implementation of **energy sharing by renewable self-consumers in the same building or multi-apartment block or within a wider geographical location** and measures to promote it in cooperation with all relevant actors*



# Scope C: Support for the implementation of the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD)

## 1. Effectiveness and coherence of instruments:

- Minimum Energy Performance Standards: Develop standards + enabling framework as part of national Building Renovation Plans
- Cost-optimality: Up-dating of methodologies



## 2. Transition to a climate-neutral building stock

- Zero Emission Buildings: Define benchmarks and criteria, support implementation
- Global Warming Potential: implementation of calculations + working towards EU framework



## 3. Optimal roll-out of buildings data and information tools

- EPCs: Rescaling and updating of calculation methodologies; integration with BRP + SRI
- Buildings Data: Methodologies to collect, aggregate, integrate and report; data governance; design of national databases + data transfer to EU-BSO

# Impacts

Topic-specific

**Proposals should demonstrate how they will contribute to:**

Increased understanding + knowledge in public administrations  
more effective/ consistent implementation of provisions, incl. better planning + evaluation of measures  
improved data quality and monitoring;  
improved understanding of potentials and barriers

**Proposals should quantify their impacts using the topic-specific indicators:**

- ✓No. public authorities with increased capacities and better access to information/ data
- ✓No. public authorities and stakeholders using tools, resources, information and data provided by activity
- ✓No. policy measures, implementing acts and related documents improved by activity
- ✓No. monitoring and reporting tools and documents improved by activity
- ✓No. references in policy-relevant documents, e.g. impact assessments
