- **relief** for the unemployed / poor


- Power of government, importance of good policy-making

 Beneficiaries (about two-thirds) are public authorities and NGOs

- Projects show how policy translates to action on the ground (local / small-scale)
- LIFE programme founded for nature protection / Birds & Habitats Directives, 1992




