# Strategic Nature Projects (SNAPs)

SNAPs:

(1) target the implementation of

- the Prioritised Action Frameworks (PAF)
- other plans or strategies adopted at international, national, regional or multiregional level by nature and biodiversity authorities, that implement EU nature and/or biodiversity policy or legislation and include specific and measurable actions, or targets, with a clear timeline and budget.

(2) at large territorial scale

(3) with the involvement of all concerned stakeholders

(4) and include a coordination mechanism that allows to mobilise other sources of funding in order to support complementary measures necessary for the full implementation of the targeted plan or strategy
