How does a proposal ensure compliance with a Territorial Just Transition Plan?	Each applicant will have to demonstrate how the project (i) benefits a territory identified in an adopted Territorial just transition plan, (ii) corresponds to one of the sectors listed in the plan and (iii) addresses the development needs set out in such plan. Questions in the Application Form will guide the applicant.	REGIO
How do you repay the loan if revenues are not generated by the project?	In order to be eligible, projects must not generate sufficient streams of revenues to cover their investment costs. The grant will be awarded in order to bridge the funding gap and help the projects become bankable. The EIB checks that risks are within a bearable threshold for this type of projects according to its rules, policies and procedures. In other words, there should be resources and revenues to repay the loan during or after the implementation but not "sufficient" to launch the project without the grant support.	EIB
Could you please develop on which projects are prioritized for receiving advisory support?	There is no prioritisation. It is on a first-come-first-served basis and there is available budget for the months to come. Advisory support is available for developing project proposals and their implementation, including for capacity building. For the public sector beneficiaries the service is for free of charge.	EIB
