SUPPORT TO THE EU MILITARY MOBILITY ACTION PLAN



In response to the call in the <u>Action plan</u> 2.0 on military mobility, the Connecting Europe Facility has contributed with a budget of EUR 1.74 billion for dual-use transport infrastructure projects.

To enhance military mobility of the European Union's armed forces within and beyond the Union, improvements on the capacity of dual-use transport infrastructure along the EU military network as well as the TEN-T network are vital for the European security and defence. Following Russia's military aggression against Ukraine, the European Commission, assisted by CINEA, accelerated the disbursement of the CEF funds of the military mobility envelope in the period from 2021 to 2023 until being fully consumed for the current 2021-2027 Multi-annual Financial Framework.

The CEF support is provided in the form of grants covering 50% of the eligible costs of a project.


CEF Transport support to Military Mobility projects



Three calls for proposals in the field of military mobility were carried out in 2021, 2022 and 2023. Overall, 95 projects were selected and are now underway in 21 member states of the European Union.

They cover all transport modes. More specifically, the projects will upgrade dual use transport infrastructure in railways, roads, airports, maritime ports, inland waterways and multimodal terminals. Ultimately, the projects will contribute to the development of multi-modal transport routes connected by logistical hubs to handle potentially heavy and large-scale military transport at short notice – which is at the heart of military mobility.
